This plan of study assumes the student has met the UA's High School Competency Requirement for Second Language and placed out of 2nd semester language course. This plan of study, therefore, only requires 2 more semesters. If the student has not fulfilled this competency requirement upon admissions, 4-8 additional units (i.e. 101 & 102 courses may be needed beyond the 120 units required for a BA degree.
