Important:

- ¹ MUS 250 is pre-requisite for the Music Education and Education courses, required for certification. To take the MEAR, students must be enrolled in MUS 250 and be passing with a grade of C or higher or have passed MUS 250 with a grade of C or higher.
- ² Students choose a minimum of 8 credits from the Technique Menu
- ³ A passing grade on the MEAR is required to proceed as a music education major. Students must pass the MEAR exam to enroll in Music Education methods courses (MUS 338M, MUS 450, MUS 451, MUS 452, and MUS 453) and College of Education courses (TLS, EDP, and LCEV courses).
- ⁴ Three options, choose one: Opt. 1: POL 210 (UA, 3 units) Opt. 2: POS 210 (Pima, 3 units) Opt. 3: AEPA Exam
- ⁵ Students must take and pass the two NES teacher certification exams prior to the student teaching semester: (1) Assessment of Professional Knowledge: Secondary; and (2) Content Assessment: Music.
- ⁶ All coursework must be completed before being admitted to Student Teaching (MUS 493M). Also required prior to Student Teaching is a minimum 3.0 GPA in your teaching major coursework, a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA for all coursework, and a grade of C or higher in all major coursework.
